

## Parish Council Accounts for the year March 31<sup>st</sup> 2015

At the end of the financial year to March 31<sup>st</sup> 2015 the audited accounts showed a balance of just over £12,000.

In 2015/16 the Parish Council successfully applied for a Lengthsman's grant of £3048 and a P3 footpaths Scheme grant of £780 and resolved not to participate in the pothole maintenance element of the Lengthsman's scheme. The parish council has also applied for a Lengthsman's grant of £3048 and a P3 footpaths Scheme grant of £780 for the coming year.

The parish council bank balance stands at around £9,500 as at 31<sup>st</sup> March - with some adjustments to be made for outstanding invoices and receipts. (£3849 L'Man & P3 grant & £500 VAT refund if claim approved as is)

There is a vacancy at the allotments in Gorsley if anyone is interested please let the council know. Priority is given to those who live within the parish. The allotment rent received continues to cover the expenditure in water rates & maintenance and various actions regarding maintenance (including the rabbit proof fence) and hedge cutting are planned.
