The Conservatives have once again taken control of the administration of the Council having the biggest number of Councillors with 21 seats. We have a Cabinet of 8 conservative members and one independent councillor who are ably assisted by two cabinet support members.

My portfolio includes all of the Council's assets mainly property and buildings together with Leisure Services and various other departments. Currently we have set up four committees to deal with several election pledges namely: The Bypass, Model Farm, Roads, and Waste Collection.
